- All Rutgers Health faculty (PIs) are eligible to submit summer internship project proposal (1 page)
- PIs are limited to one application per cycle
- Intern applicants can be Bachelors or Masters-level students from any RU School, Institute, or CLU

## **Details**

- 7 Summer Internships supported annually
- \$3,000 stipend to student Interns
- \$1,000 to faculty for project needs
- Nine-week program (June 2 August 1, 2025)
