2025 Request for Applications Cycle 3 (PATHWAY 1 ONLY)

The LHS STAR NJ program is excited to announce the 3rd cycle of its Learning Health System (LHS) Scholars Training Program, which aims to cultivate a new generation of leaders in LHS Science. The program provides LHS education, training, mentorship, and career development opportunities for scholars and researchers, as well as health system, insurer, and government personnel.

Participants will: 1) receive access to training in Comparative Effectiveness Research (CER),
Dissemination and Implementation (D&I) Science and Patient-Centered Outcomes Research (PCOR);
2) conduct impactful LHS projects; and 3) disseminate and implement findings.

The program offers three training pathways that can be tailored to the background and interest of the participants.

For Cycle 3, applications are only being accepted for Pathway 1.

Pathway 1

- Ideal for junior faculty aiming for careers as independent investigators.
- Commit up to 50% effort to LHS research.
- Receive up to \$50,000/year for up to two years (2nd year contingent on available funds/progress).
